
SIR PETER BLAKE'S 90TH SHOW

Today a star studded lineup curated by Paul Weller has been announced in celebration of Sir Peter Blake's 90th year. The event will take place on the 2nd December 2022 at the Royal Festival Hall, London and promises to be a truly unforgettable evening celebrating one of the

true greats of British popular culture. The line up will comprise of an eclectic mixture of acoustic and electric performances from Madness, Noel Gallagher, Roger Daltrey, Paul Weller, Chrissie Hynde and Baxter Dury, with John Wilson from BBC Radio 4 compering the evening. All the artists have a close personal connection to Blake, emphasised by Paul Weller stating that "We're coming to celebrate this brilliant artist who has given us all so much for over 70 years! Thank you Peter!"

Sir Peter Blake has been at the very forefront of English pop culture since the 1960's and was knighted in 2002 for his services to art. He has been an integral part of creating some iconic pieces of art, including the co-creation of the sleeve design for the Beatles' album Sgt. Pepper's Lonely Hearts Club Band. Blake is also known for having designed the 2012 Brit Awards Statuette.

All proceeds from the event will be split between the Teenage Cancer Trust and Graeae Theatre Company. Teenage Cancer Trust's core ethos is that a cancer diagnosis shouldn't define who a young person is. Through their expert nurses, support teams, and hospital units, they are the only UK charity dedicated to providing this specialised nursing care and support which puts young people in the best possible place, physically, mentally and emotionally, for their cancer treatment and beyond. Proceeds will also go to the Graeae Theatre Company, of whom Sir Peter is a founder Patron. Graeae is an acclaimed and award-winning theatre company, existing to cultivate and champion the best in Deaf, disabled and neurodivergent talent on the UK and international stages. Graeae is a force for change in world-class theatre, boldly placing Deaf and disabled actors centre stage.

Speaking about Sir Peter Blake, artistic director of Graeae and co-director of the London 2012 Paralympic Opening Ceremony, Jenny Sealey MBE, says "Peter Blake is a legendary part of Graeae as a patron, an artist and the kindest person ever. He has twinkly eyes but stands for no nonsense, ever the radical maverick we hold close to our hearts. Happy Birthday Peter and so much love from your Graeae family."
