

The Paradis Files contains references to some distressing topics, including physical violence, sexual abuse, baby loss, bereavement, ableism and graphic depictions of seventeenth century 'cures' for blindness, including compression of the optic nerve, bleeding with pins and electric shock.

## **Glossary of terms:**

#### **Ableism**

discrimination against disabled people or people who someone believes to be disabled

## **Baby loss**

includes loss during and after pregnancy, stillbirth, miscarriage, neonatal death and SIDS.

#### **Bereavement**

the experience of losing someone important to us. It is characterised by grief, which is the process and the range of emotions we go through as we gradually adjust to the loss.

## **Physical violence**

when someone hurts or harms someone on purpose.

#### Premature birth

When a baby is born too early, before 37 weeks of pregnancy. Very early babies will need specialist medical care.

#### Sexual abuse

Unwanted sexual touch, this means without consent. Includes rape, sexual assault, sexual violence and others.

#### Stillbirth

A stillbirth is the death of a baby after 24 weeks of pregnancy but before birth.
