How to communicate with a Deaf person - Do:

- 1. Ensure good lighting on your face
 - 2. Speak clearly
 - 3. Speak at your natural pace
 - 4. Make eye contact
 - 5. Keep to the point
 - 6. Use your natural gesture
 - 7. Use writing if you get stuck
- 8. Remember that communication is a two-way thing
 - 9. Just be you don't give up!

How NOT to communicate with a Deaf person - Don't:

1. Shout



- 2. Cover your mouth with your hands
 - 3. Turn your back to them
- 4. Stand with your back to the light, making lipreading difficult
 - 5. Chew gum or talk with your mouth full
- 6. Gesture wildly, waving your hands in front of your face
 - 7. Exaggerate your lip pattern
 - 8. Speak very, very slowly
 - 9. Speak as you would to a small child
