BEFORE THE SHOW



The **Box Office** is on the **left hand side** as you enter through the **main doors**.

Our **Front of House** and **Box Office Assistants** will be wearing **navy blue t-shirts** and **orange lanyards**.

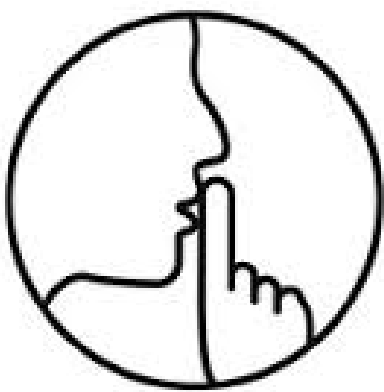
They will be happy to help if you need **assistance**.

There is a **bar** on the **first floor** of the theatre.

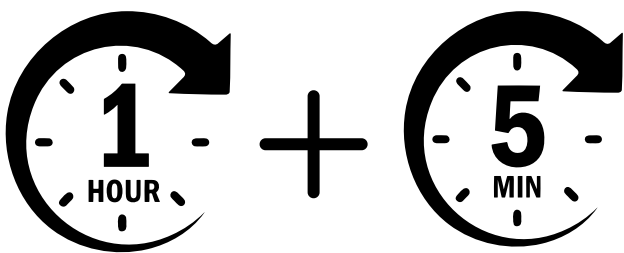


There will be **announcements** over the speakers saying when the show will **start**.

There is **no break.**

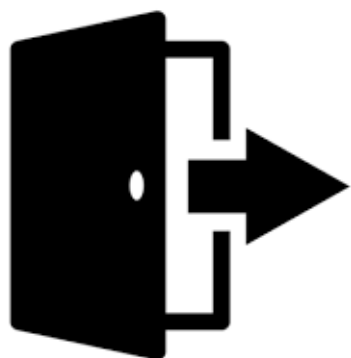
ACCESS INFORMATION

- Examples of the set

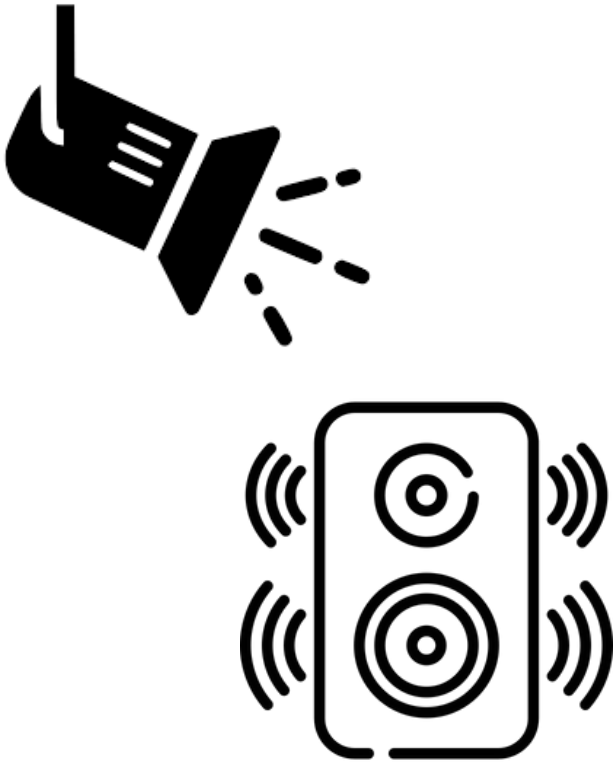


The **show** is performed in a **relaxed environment**.

ABOUT THE PLAY

Bad Lads is a **new play**, written by **Mike Kenny**, created from a **story** by **Jimmy Coffey** and **the other Medomsley boys**.

Medomsley was a detention centre for young men who had been caught breaking the law.

While they were there, these boys were abused and harmed by the adults who were meant to be taking care of them.

This play has been created from the real life stories of young men who were sent to Medomsley.

Bad Lads calls for justice for these men.

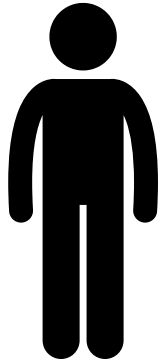

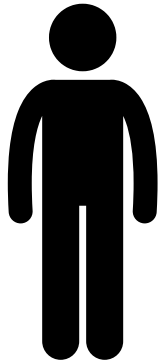
WHAT HAPPENS IN THE SHOW



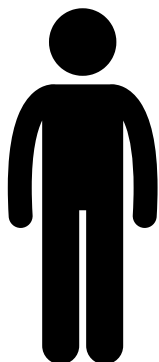
The **play** tells the **story** of a man called **Jackie**.

The **story** is **told** by **three actors**.

This is **Younger Jackie**.



This is **Older Jackie**.



This is **Signing Jackie**.

WHAT HAPPENS IN THE SHOW

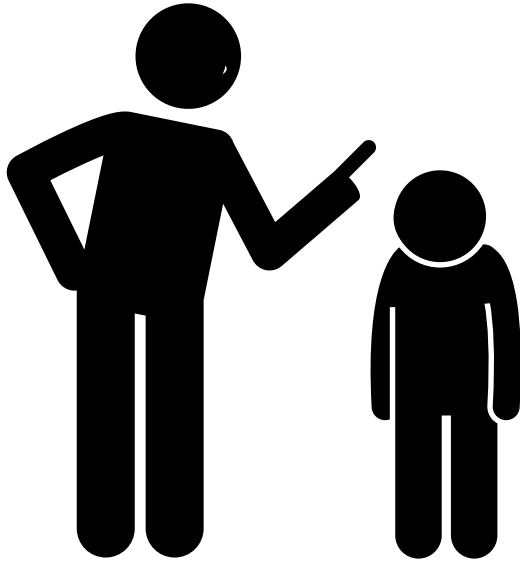


When **Jackie** was **17** years old, he **stole** a **milk van** with his **friends**.



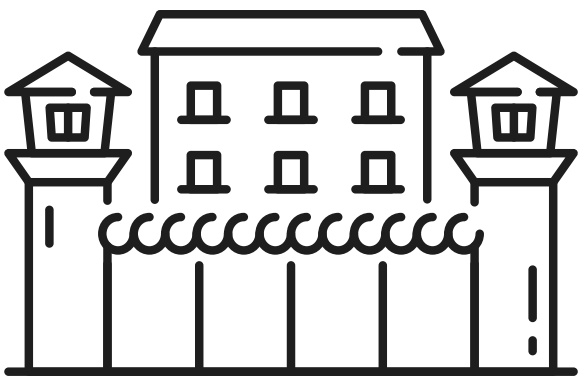
Jackie was **caught** by the **police** and was **arrested**.

WHAT HAPPENS IN THE SHOW



There was a **new way** of **punishing** naughty boys called the '**Short Sharp Shock**' treatment.

It meant **sending** the **boys** to **youth detention centres** for a **short time**.



Jackie was sent to a **detention centre** called **Medomsley**.

He had to stay there for **three months**.

WHAT HAPPENS IN THE SHOW



Jackie was **driven** to **Medomsley** by some friendly policemen.



When **Jackie** arrived at **Medomsley**, he **met** the **horrible guards** for the **first time**.

WHAT HAPPENS IN THE SHOW

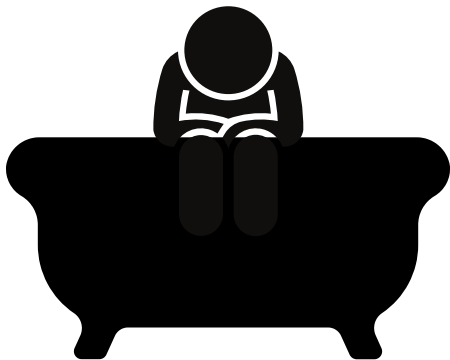


The guards were called **Big John, Puppet, and Broken Nose.**

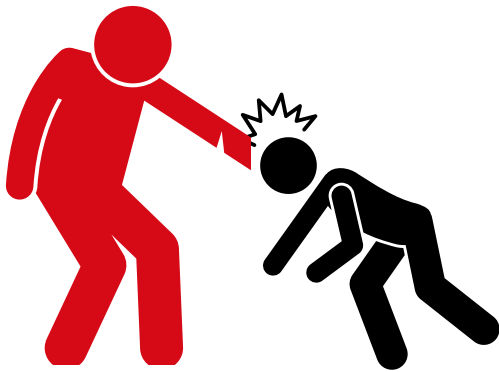
They were very **cruel** to **Jackie.**



The **guards** made **Jackie** have a **cold bath** and **they shouted and laughed** at him.

Puppet hit **Jackie** because he **did not** call him **Sir**.

Jackie was hurt.

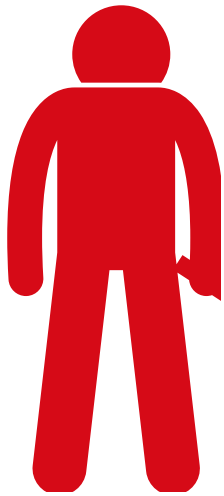


Jackie was scared because he had **never** been away from home before.



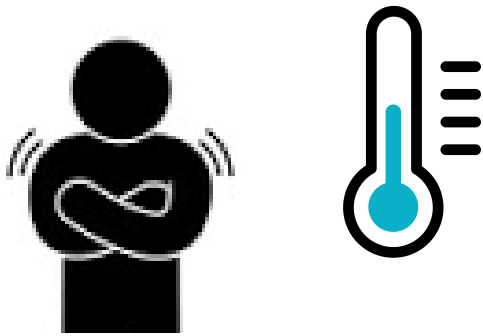
The **next morning**, **Jackie** was forced to wake up early to run around the **fence** in the **freezing cold**.

A **guard** called **Onslow** was the **worst guard**.

He was **violent** towards the boys.



The **boys** had to **work hard at chores** in the **freezing cold**.



Onslow hit **Jackie** when he was cleaning the floor and **Jackie** was **hurt again**.

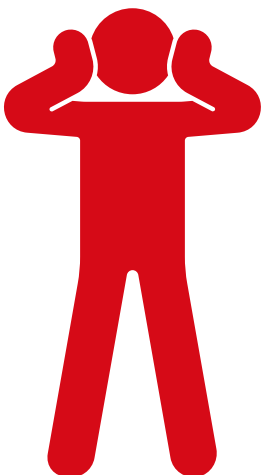
WHAT HAPPENS IN THE SHOW



Jackie saw that he could **work** in the **kitchen**, where it was **warm**.



Other boys **warned** him to **stay away** from the **kitchen**, but **Jackie** wanted to **work** in the **warm**.



The **Medomsley** chef **was** called **Neville Husband**.
He was a **horrible** man.

WHAT HAPPENS IN THE SHOW



Husband touched Jackie, pretending to **measure** him for a kitchen **uniform**.



Husband got **too close to Jackie** in the **kitchen**.

He sexually abused Jackie.



Husband forced Jackie to **kiss** him, even though he **did not want to**.

WHAT HAPPENS IN THE SHOW



Jackie was very frightened.

He worried about what might **happen** each **day** in the **kitchen**.

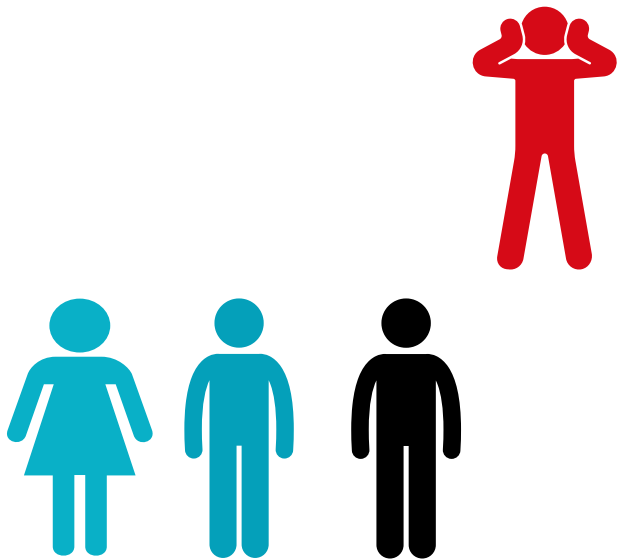


Husband made **Jackie** go to his house.



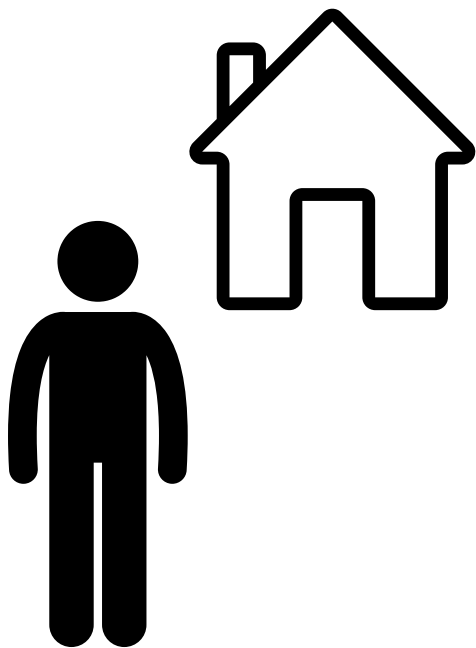
Jackie was **sexually** **abused** by **Husband** many times.

Jackie's **Mum and Dad** went to **visit** him at **Medomsley**.

Jackie could not tell them the **truth** because **Husband** was **listening**.



After three months, it was **time** for **Jackie** to go **home** to his **family**.

WHAT HAPPENS IN THE SHOW



His **family** were **happy** to see him but things at **home** were **different**.

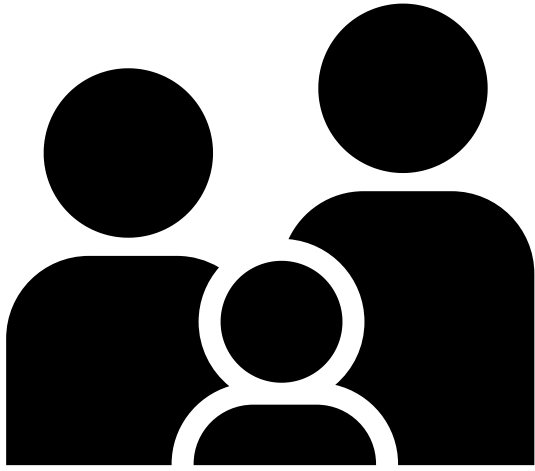
Jackie **felt different** now.



Jackie became **very unhappy**.

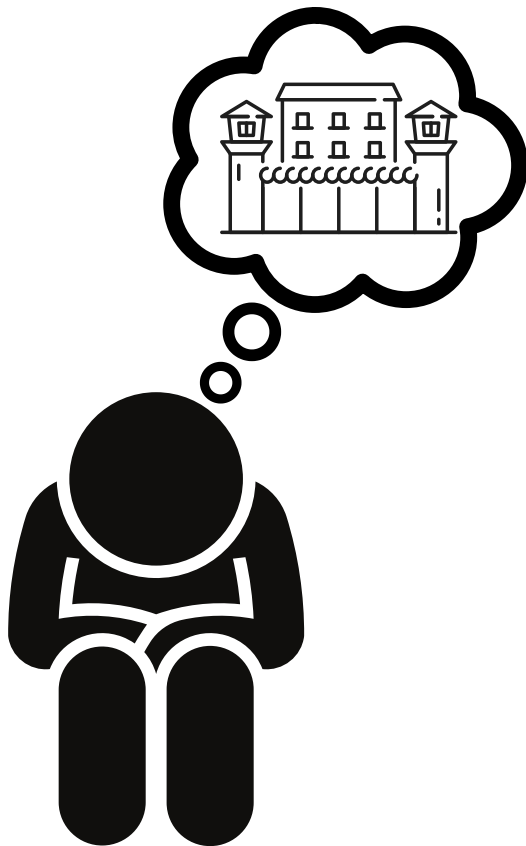
He could not stop thinking about the **bad things** that happened to him at **Medomsley**.

Jackie tried to **move on** with his **life**.

He got **married** and had a **family**.



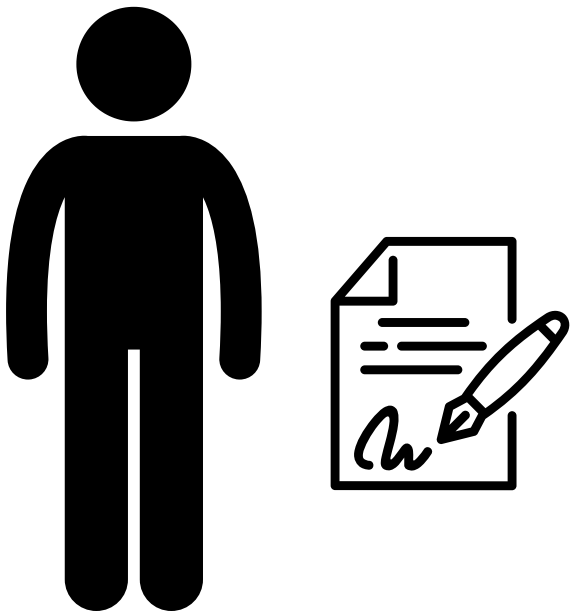
Jackie could **never forget** the **horrible experiences** he had at **Medomsley**.

WHAT HAPPENS IN THE SHOW



Many **years later** **Jackie** received a **letter** from the **police**.

There was going to be a **police investigation** called **Operation Seabrook**.



The **letter** asked **Jackie** to **tell the police** about the **bad things** that happened to him at **Medomsley**.

WHAT HAPPENS IN THE SHOW



Jackie did not want to talk to the **police**, he **could not tell** anyone what **happened** to him.



Jackie felt hopeless and **wanted to die**.

WHAT HAPPENS IN THE SHOW



Jackie remembered being **taken** to a **house** by **Husband**.

It was **Christmas** time and there was a **party**.



Jackie's head was **covered** so **he could not see** where he was.

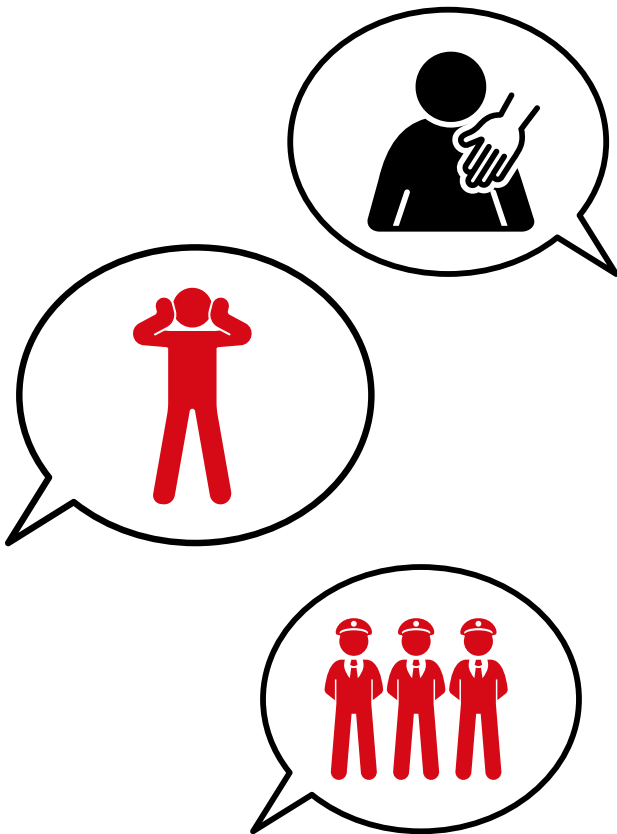
Jackie was **sexually abused** by a **group of men** at the **party**.

WHAT HAPPENS IN THE SHOW



Jackie decided he had to **talk** about what **happened**.

The **police** **interviewed Jackie** and **many** of the **other boys** who went to **Medomsley**.

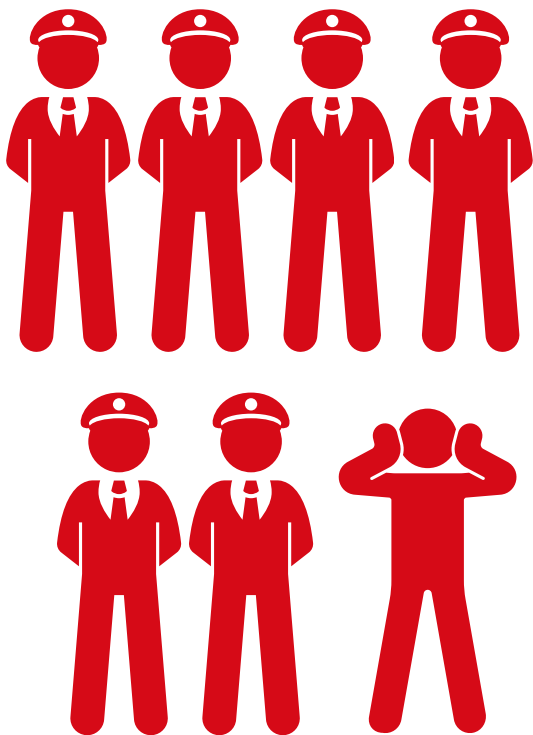


All of the **boys** had **terrible stories** to tell about how they were **treated** so **badly** there.

WHAT HAPPENS IN THE SHOW



Jackie went to **court** and **told** the story of what **happened to** him.



Seven of the **Medomsley guards**, including **Husband** were found **guilty** of **abuse** and went to **prison**.

WHAT HAPPENS IN THE SHOW

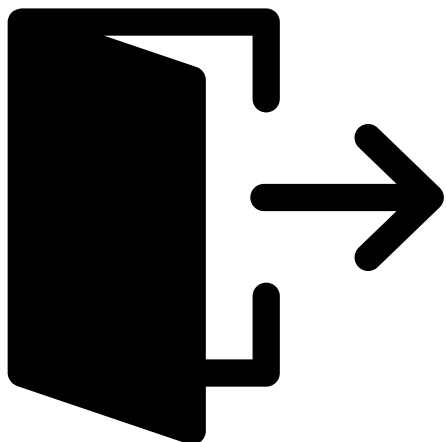


None of the **guards** **admitted** that they **hurt** the **boys** at **Medomsley**, even though they were found **guilty**.

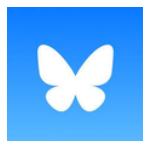
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
