





When is the Hearing?




The hearing is taking place on **Thursday, 12 March**.



The **hearing** will **begin** at **9:30 AM** for **private** discussions.


This **part** will **not** be on **television** or **live-streamed**.

This part **will be** on **television** and **live-streamed**.


The Hearing

One stream has **British Sign Language Interpretation.**


The **other** stream **does not** have **sign language.**




The **room** will be **set up** like the image to the left.

The Hearing




There will be **four people** at the **hearing** who **work** for **Access to Work**.

- **Bill Thorpe**


What happens at The Hearing?



The **Public Accounts Committee** are **people** who have been **chosen** to do a **task**.

What happens at the Hearing?

The **managers** will need to **answer questions** about these **problems** and **think** about how they can **fix** them.


What happens after the Hearing?
